



How to Check Your Times on the ASA Database

Times achieved at a licensed gala will be on the ASA's database.

The rankings database is available via the ASA's web site at <http://www.britishswimming.co.uk/> (look for a link on the right hand side of the page "Rankings / Blogs / Home Country Membership – Click here"). There is also a link on the Fixtures page of our web site at <http://www.northwichasc.co.uk/Html/Fixtures>

From the Rankings web page click on the "all swims for over 5,500,000 times to search since 1997" link.

These are only 2 fields that are important (all the other fields should be left with their defaults):

Membership number or family name:

This is your **ASA Membership** number not your NASC Number.

If you don't know your **ASA Membership** number, enter your family name and Click 'Go Looking'. This will give you a list of all the registered people with that family name. Find yourself and click on the number against your name on the left. This will take you back to the page with your membership number completed for you. Make a note of this number.

Check for all stroke's times instead of ranking

Ensure that this is ticked.

Now click on the 'Go looking' button.

This should give you a list of ALL your times on the ASA database. These are the time that you must use to enter the gala.
